Fælles beslutningstagning og dialysevalg: en komplex intervention

Fælles beslutningstagning og dialysevalg: en komplex intervention er et ph.d.-projekt fra Aarhus Universitet, Health. Projektet er gennemført af Jeanette Finderup, der forsvarer det d. 28/08. Patienter med nyresvigt skal i samarbejde med læger og sygeplejerske vælge, om de behandles med hæmodialyse eller peritoneal dialyse. De skal også vælge, om behandlingen skal foregå hjemme hos dem selv eller på hospitalet. Dette ph.d.-projekt evaluerede den komplekse intervention, Fælles beslutningstagning og Dialysevalg. Formålet med interventionen var at involvere patienterne i beslutningsprocessen for at sikre, at de fik den behandling, der var mest passende i netop deres tilfælde. Interventionen er blevet implementeret på fire hospitaler i Danmark. vi fandt, at interventionen involverede patienterne i aktivt at træffe beslutning om dialyseform, og at flere patienter, sammenlignet med tidligere beslutningspraksis, valgte behandling hjemme fremfor på hospital.

Shared decision-making and dialysis choice: a complex intervention

Shared decision-making and dialysis choice: a complex intervention is a new PhD project from Aarhus University, Health. The project was carried out by Jeanette Finderup, who is defending her dissertation on 28/08. Patients with kidney failure must in collaboration with the healthcare professionals choose between treatment with haemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis. They must also decide whether the treatment shall take place at home or at hospital. The PhD-project evaluated the complex intervention Shared Decision-Making and Dialysis Choice. The purpose of the intervention was to involve the patient in the decision-making process and to ensure that the patient received the most suitable treatment. The intervention has been implemented at four different hospitals in Denmark. We found that the intervention involved the patients in actively deciding on dialysis



modality, and that more patients, compared to previous decision-making practices, chose treatment at home rather than at hospital.
