Ph.d-forsvar om arbejdets betydning for lyskebrokoperation

Mandag den 29. oktober 2018 forsvare Marie Vestergaard Vad sit ph.d.-projekt ved Aarhus Universitet, Health.

Marie Vestergaard Vad er læge og har de seneste år forsket i, hvordan stående og gående arbejde påvirker risikoen for lyskebrokoperation. Samtidig har hun undersøgt, hvad arbejdet betyder for patienternes smerter og bedring efter operationen.

Lyskebrok er ét af de mest almindelige kirurgiske indgreb blandt danske mænd i den erhvervsaktive alder. Maries forskning tyder på, at nogle af disse lyskebrok-operationer måske kunne være undgået.

Det fortæller hun mere om ved forsvaret af ph.d.-afhandlingen "Predictors of inguinal hernia repair and persistent postoperative pain - impact of occupational mechanical exposures".

PhD defence: Influence of work exposures on inguinal hernia repair

Monday the 29th of October, Marie Vestergaard Vad will be defending her PhD dissertation at Aarhus University, Health.

Over the past couple of years Marie Vestergaard Vad, medical doctor, has been investigating how walking and standing- hours/day influence the risk of inguinal hernia repair. Her research also digs into the impact of work on persistent postoperative pain.

Inguinal hernia repair is one of the most common surgical repairs among working-age men in Denmark. Marie Vestergaard Vad's research indicates that some of these repairs could have been avoided. She will be going further into this when defending her dissertation "Predictors of inguinal hernia repair and persistent postoperative pain - impact of occupational mechanical exposures".

The defence is public and takes place on 29th of October at 14 pm in Eduard Biermann Auditoriet, Aarhus University, Vennelyst Boulevard 8, 8000 Aarhus C.
